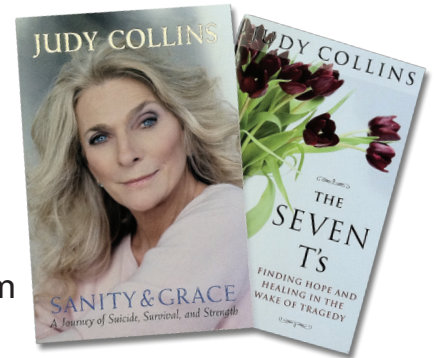

On April 25th, Judy will address the topics in her book, **Sanity and Grace, A Journey of Suicide, Survival and Strength**, a deeply moving memoir focusing on the death of her only son and her healing process following the tragedy.
