Help us Better Understand How to Prevent Cancer

Join the American Cancer Center's Cancer Prevention Study-3

If you're like most people, you want to see an end to cancer in your lifetime. You can be part of this incredible cause by participating in a landmark research study conducted by The American Cancer Society (ACS). The ultimate goal is to help cancer researchers better understand the lifestyle, environmental and genetic factors that cause or prevent cancer and will save lives.

ACS is looking for at least 300,000 adults in the U.S. to participate in the study. *While research will be collected for 20 to 30 years, your overall time commitment during the course of the study is about eight hours.*



You may qualify if...

- You are willing to make a long-term commitment to the study. *Initial enrollment requires a comprehensive baseline survey that can be completed online, followed by a 20 to 30-minute appointment that includes a brief survey, a signed consent to participate, a waist measurement and a small blood sample. Brief surveys are then completed at home every few years.*
- You are between the ages of 30 and 65.
- You have never been diagnosed with cancer.

Participation is easy and enrollment is available in your local community thanks to partnerships with [St. Luke's University Health Network](#) and First Presbyterian Church in Bethlehem.
