More than 50% of the children seen on the van have never been to a dentist—and untreated dental conditions often lead to pain, missed school days, and decreased self-esteem.

St. Luke's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) received its newest piece of lifesaving equipment, thanks to a generous donation from the Lehigh Valley Commercial & Industrial Real Estate Foundation (LVCIRE). The equipment, a GE Giraffe Shuttle, protects the tiniest and most vulnerable newborns as they are transported from the birthing room to the NICU without any disruption in critical care.




The Gift That Pays You
