OVERALL PROGRAM GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1. Expand the scope and depth of the resident's knowledge and skills so that they may provide comprehensive general dentistry and oral health care to a wide range of populations including those with special needs.
- 2. Develop ability to manage medically compromised hospital patients in ambulatory and in-patient settings utilizing a multidisciplinary approach in the provision of oral health care.
- 3. Develop the ability to function appropriately and effectively as a member of an interdisciplinary health team, both within the hospital and other health care settings.
- 4. Residents of the program will apply scientific principles and technical skills competently for the purposes of developing appropriate patient and practice management skills.
- 5. Residents will apply the values of professional ethics, lifelong learning and cultural diversity in directing patient care and health promotions and disease prevention.
- 6. Apply the concepts of patient/practice management and quality improvement in order to impact positively on the oral health needs of the community where they work.
