FAMILY MEDICINE

You will become a welcome member of our team in our 17,000 square foot out-patient family practice center. We offer our community a full range of services including obstetrics, nutrition counseling and family counseling. We perform many procedures at our office:

During your rotation you will have the opportunity to work with our attendings and residents, actively examine patients, present them to our preceptors and formulate an assessment and therapeutic plan. SURGERY
