<p>Talk to the Admissions team about your college/university prerequisites.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All applicants are highly encouraged to send their unofficial transcripts to the Admissions team for advising prior to applying. The Admissions team will tell you which application deadline to follow. - At least six out of the eight prerequisites must be completed by October 31, 2022 shown on official transcripts. 	<p>Prior to application</p>
<p>Complete the online application found on our website at slhn.org/son.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The application fee is \$35 and can be paid online by credit card or with a check made payable to "St. Luke's School of Nursing." - Applicants are also asked to submit a resume at the time of application. - Applications must be submitted by October 31st to be considered. 	<p>All applicants are encouraged to submit the online application by October 31st 2022</p>
<p>Request official transcripts be sent to St. Luke's School of Nursing by <u>ALL</u> educational and training institutions attended from high school and beyond.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Send transcripts from institutions attended, not just the schools where prerequisites were completed. - If the applicant received a GED, an official GED transcript must be submitted in addition to any partial high school transcripts. 	<p>Make your transcript requests at least six weeks in advance of the deadline so all transcripts arrive by the deadline</p>
<p>Applicants who attended school outside of the United States must provide a credential evaluation of their transcripts from WES (www.wes.org) or ECE (www.ece.org).</p>	<p>For brand new evaluations, start the process 6 months prior to the final application deadline</p>
<p>Register for and complete the ATI Critical Thinking Exam at our campus.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Admissions team will send testing dates to applicants shortly after the application is accepted and processed. The cost of the exam is \$35, payable the day of the test via credit or with a check made payable to "St. Luke's School of Nursing." - Other entrance exams are not accepted. 	<p>Two attempts are offered for the exam once we have received your transcripts you will be offered time and dates for the testing</p>
<p>Submit two references on the official reference form found on the application page at slhn.org/son.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - References must be from a professional, academic, or advisory source. - Personal references are not accepted. - Applicants who have taken nursing courses leading to RN licensure must submit recommendations from the Director of the formerly enrolled Nursing program or the most recent nursing instructor, utilizing the "Recommendation Form for Applicants from Other RN Programs." 	<p>All applicants must submit recommendations before an interview is scheduled</p>
<p>Qualified applicants will be asked to participate in a face-to-face interview with members of St. Luke's School of Nursing's faculty and/or administration.</p>	<p>All applicants will be sent times and dates available once admissions receives all required documents</p>
<p>Send in your final transcripts, if applicable.</p>
