NEW LABOR & DELIVERY VISITATION POLICY

Your health and your baby's health are our number one priority.

We have modified our visitation policy to help ensure the protection of you and all of our patients, visitors and staff.

- You may bring only one visitor for your entire stay.
- You both will be pre-screened for COVID-19 symptoms via phone prior to arrival at hospital.
- Upon arrival at the hospital, you will also be screened, and we will take your temperatures. If your visitor has a fever, they will not be allowed into the unit and will be referred to receive appropriate clinical care as indicated.
- You both will be required to mask throughout the hospital stay. You are welcome
 to bring masks from home. If you don't have masks, those will be provided.
- You and your visitor must remain in your room at all times.
- Visitors will not be permitted in the triage area but will be able to join you once admitted.
- Visitors will not be permitted to reenter if they leave the Labor & Delivery unit.

We recognize that this policy is challenging and not ideal. To help, we will provide complimentary visitor meals for the duration of your stay.
