

# NEW LABOR & DELIVERY VISITATION POLICY

**Your health and your baby's health are our number one priority.**

We have modified our visitation policy to help ensure the protection of you and all of our patients, visitors and staff.

- You may bring only one visitor for your entire stay.
- You both will be pre-screened for COVID-19 symptoms via phone prior to arrival at hospital.
- Upon arrival at the hospital, you will also be screened, and we will take your temperatures. If your visitor has a fever, they will not be allowed into the unit and will be referred to receive appropriate clinical care as indicated.
- You both will be required to mask throughout the hospital stay. You are welcome to bring masks from home. If you don't have masks, those will be provided.
- You and your visitor must remain in your room at all times.
- Visitors will not be permitted in the triage area but will be able to join you once admitted.
- Visitors will not be permitted to reenter if they leave the Labor & Delivery unit.

We recognize that this policy is challenging and not ideal. To help, we will provide **complimentary visitor meals** for the duration of your stay.
